Aims and objectives of the training activities and study visits:

- Learn about internationalization of Higher Education Institutions
- To enable participants to get to know the reality of the Internationalization of higher education institutions, their functioning and their policies.

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- Learn more about international cooperation actions and projects.
- To encourage possible partnerships between HEI with similar interests or backgrounds/history.
- Learn concrete tools and strategies to promote the internationalization, specifically: internationalization of research, internationalization of the curriculum, internationalization and third mission, and
- Network with others working on the same topic or area.
- To encourage mutual understanding and learning.
- Explore potential for follow-up activities, especially within the framework of Erasmus+.

This call is intended for teachers, researchers and administrative workers who would like to learn more about internationalization of higher education institutions.

In order to be able to participate in this call, you need to:

- Age 18+
- Hold a valid Passport
- Open minded, good teamwork, respect others and willing to learn something new.
- Preferable to have participated at least one of below projects:
 - CAMINOS Project
 - o DHIP Project
 - The Crux Project
 - Women4Peace Project
- Applicants must be active full-time teacher, researcher or administrative staff member at UDES
- Must be working on internationalization of curriculum, internationalization of research, internationalization of third mission, academic cooperation, internationalization of management issues.
- Have experience in working with foreign people and culturally diverse.
- Be able to work in English, excellent command / highly proficient in spoken and written English.
- There are eight (8) places available. The selection will be based on the information provided in the application form.

Application procedure:

Candidates should express their interest and motivation for joining the activities by filling in the enclosed application form (Annex 1) and sending it to <u>relacionesinternacionales@udes.edu.co</u> no later than 22th august 2019 – 11:59 AM (morning). Applicants will be notified on the selection results by 26th of august 2019.



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The applicants must include a short video (less than 5 minutes), providing at least the following information:

- Personal information. Who are you and what do you do?
- What are you applying for? Where?
- Mention the general reason on why you are applying, and then deep-dive in your professional interest.
- Why should you be chosen above the other applicants?

The video can be uploaded to YouTube and share the link to the abovementioned email address.

Selection Criteria:

The candidates will be selected on the basis of personal motivation, intercultural abilities, knowledge of English.

The Assignments (all obligatory):

During the training activities:

- Support the promotional activities.
- Be able to complete training activities successfully.

During the study visit:

- Send pictures and video/ footage of their departure and during projects regularly to UdesInternational staff
- Post, tag and mention UDES social media when posting documentation related to this project
- Communicate regulary with UdesInternational staff during the study visit.

Post project:

- Submit report of participation at the latest 3 working days after arrived.
- Join one international or bilateral networking activity as participant.
- Support the promotional activities with Udes staff.
- Disseminate acquired knowledge to the UDES academic community, and submit a report on their findings.

The program covers:

The projects are funded by the Erasmus+ Programme. Thus, all expenses for accommodation, food, local transport during and for project in each study visit and international travel costs are fully covered.

The program does NOT cover:

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- Personal medication
- Passport/visa fee
- Personal expenses during transit and project
